

Information (Info) Session

An Information Session or Info Session is a 3-hour educational class with a Domestic Violence Advocate. The required 3 hours will be broken up into 2 or 3 separate meetings. In your session you can expect to learn about the cycle of violence, lethality indicators or red flags, healthy relationships, safety planning and a lot more.

- Your first step in beginning this process is to call or email requesting an Info session.

- Next a Coordinator will assign you to an Advocate.
- Then the assigned Advocate will then reach out to you to schedule a date and time to begin your first session. At this time, you and your Advocate can decide how to split up your sessions, and weather or not you will meet in person or virtually.
- Then you just participate and complete your sessions (participation is required)
- When your session is concluded your YWCA Advocate will ask if you would like to continue meeting with them. This is free and optional service provided by the YWCA and it can be very helpful. Our Advocates are very knowledgeable when dealing with Domestic Violence, they are supportive and can also offer help with finding resources, such as housing or employment.
